PER CURIAM.

Plaintiff appeals as of right the circuit court's order granting defendant's motion to terminate a personal protection order. The underlying personal protection order would have expired according to its own terms on September 11, 2016, and plaintiff has not identified any collateral consequences that arose out of the circuit court's order granting defendant's motion. See *Visser v Visser*, 495 Mich 862, 862-863; 836 NW2d 693 (2013); see also *Hayford v Hayford*, 279 Mich App 324, 325; 760 NW2d 503 (2008). Thus, we dismiss the appeal as moot. This appeal is being decided without oral argument pursuant to MCR 7.214(E).
